Grammar

Have / Has = Present tense + wedi

This is the perfect tense. You can think of 'wedi' as meaning 'have' or 'has' here. The present tense patterns are used but 'wedi' is substituted for 'yn', e.g.

Dw i'n bwyta cinio. > I am eating dinner.

Dw i wedi bwyta cinio. > I have eaten dinner.

'Wedi' and 'yn' never appear next to each other.

One way to get the Welsh equivalent of the above type of English phrase is to:

1) put the English phrase the long way round:

the children's toys > the toys of the children.

2) get rid of the first 'the' and the first 'of' in the phrase:

the toys of the children.
