Who are you?

My Name is Gail Harris, and I am the Nursery manager of Coleg y Cymoedd Day Nursery in Ystrad Mynach, Hengoed, Caerphilly.

Your setting and the welsh language:

Our Day nursery is an English-Speaking setting with incidental Welsh used throughout the nursery day through greetings, songs, rhymes and simple words and phrases. Along with all of our displays being bilingual.

We would have loved a fluent Welsh speaking member of staff to help promote the Welsh Language so when we had the opportunity to enrol on to a beginner's Welsh course for Early Years practitioners that was FREE of charge we jumped at the chance.

During Lockdown we found that we had more time to complete courses relevant to our nursery roles and Camau mynediad 1 was suggested as an ideal starting point for our staff.

My team of 8 staff had no background in learning Welsh and little confidence in using Welsh in the workplace, so we all took up the challenge of level 1.

The course:

It was good to find that this course was relevant to Early years settings and the simple way to navigate and complete the units was easy even for those staff with little or no IT skills. We looked at Numbers, Colours, days of the week, seasons, greetings, and basic commands to mention just a few topics covered in the units. It is also beneficial that staff can revisit the units repeatedly to refresh their knowledge and make use of the resources available. We introduced singing simple songs at circle time and now use the You Tube channel for singing Welsh songs.

We also took advantage of the Welsh Language coordinator's offer to link in with us over teams/Zoom she reads simple stories / picture books followed by a sing along and continue to do so now.

Level 1 was completed over a period of several weeks and we were encouraged to complete level 2 soon afterwards but for me as a manager, I was keen to get staff confident in using what they had learned in Level 1 before attempting level 2.

2 staff members completed level 2 soon afterwards.

Whole setting feedback:

Staff said:

"It's good to see a course relevant to Early Years and it has given me the confidence to try these new words and phrases with the children"

"The layout made it easy to navigate around and the graphics made the process more appealing and enjoyable"

"We all enjoyed the sing along sessions after completing the level 1 course – we looked forward to our weekly get togethers over Zoom"
