Activity suggestion – **Awgrymiad o Weithgaredd**

Setting the table – **Gosod y bwrdd**

To familiarise the children with the new Welsh words, encourage the children to find objects to set the table.

Use the objects in the home corner or role-play area to familiarise the children with the objects initially; you could ask the children to take it in turns to find the object/objects you need to set the table.

You could draw a placemat for each child on the table with a picture of a plate and cutlery so they can copy where to place the object or use the template provided below.

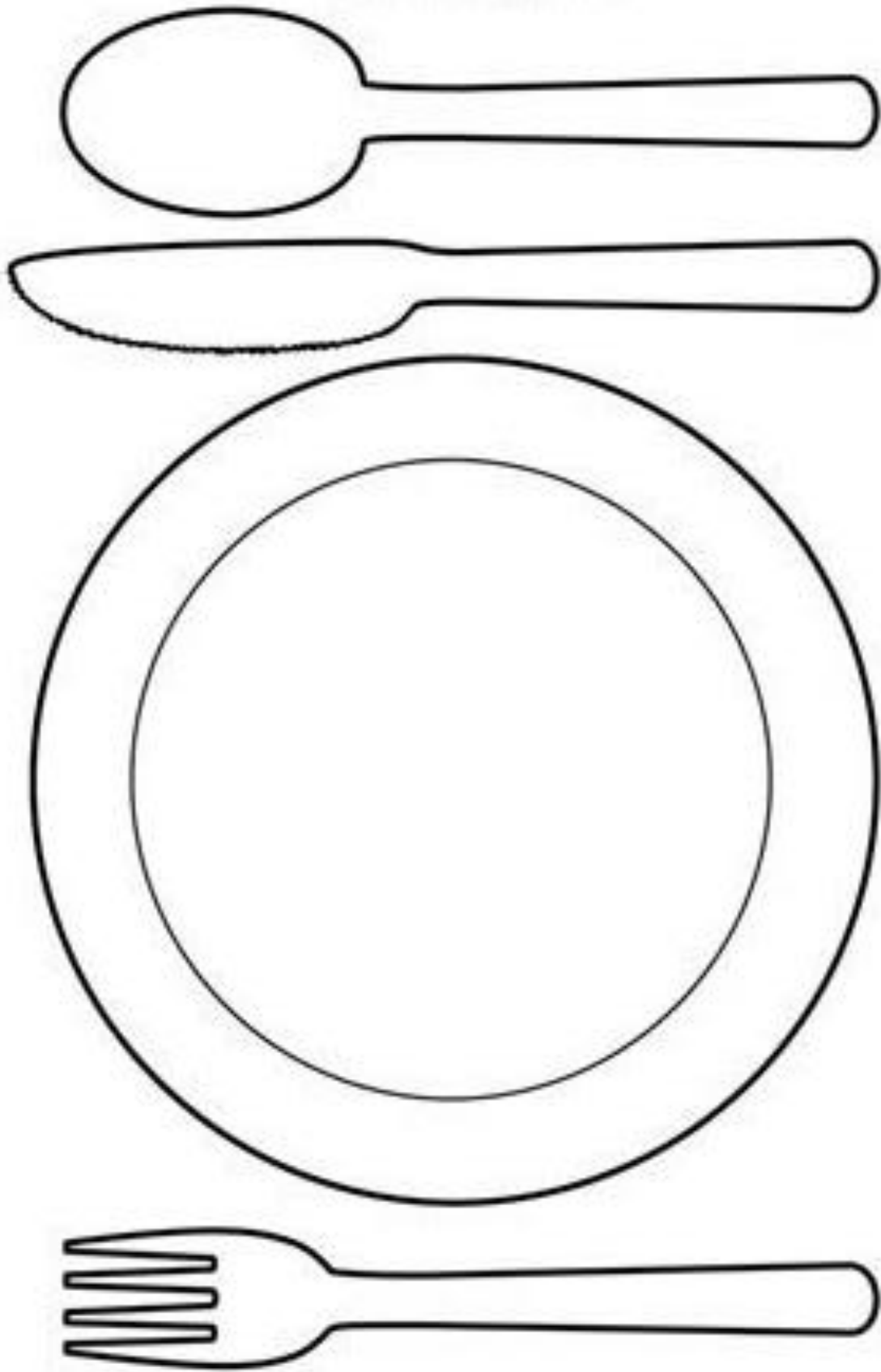

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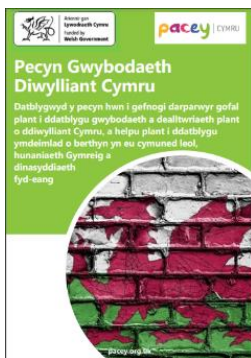
